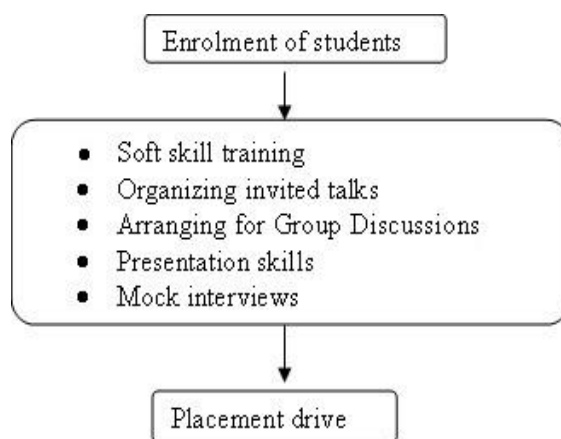


Career Guidance, Training and Placement
