About NSS:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is an Indian government-sponsored public service program conducted by the Department of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India. **Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhiji's centenary year, 1969. NSS activity is one of the primary activities for social services and learning importance at the very young stage while students are graduating.**

Objectives of NSS

- Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem-solving. Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.

- Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes.
- Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters.
- Practice national integration and social harmony

Motto of NSS

The motto of NSS, "Not Me But You," reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service. NSS helps the student's development & appreciation to other persons' points of view and also shows consideration towards other living beings. The philosophy of the NSS is a good doctrine in this motto, which underlines the belief that the welfare of an individual is ultimately dependent on the welfare of the society as a whole, and therefore, the NSS volunteers shall strive for the well-being of the society.

NSS SYMBOL

The symbol of the National Service Scheme, as appearing on the cover, is based on the 'Rath' wheel of the Konark Sun Temple, portrays the cycle of creation, preservation, and release, and signifies the movement in life across time and space. The design of the symbol, a simplified form of the sun chariot wheel, primarily depicts movement. The wheel signifies the progressive cycle of life. It stands for continuity as well as change and implies on the part of the NSS continuous striving forward for social transformation and upliftment.

NSS BADGE

The NSS symbol is embossed on the NSS badge. NSS volunteers wear it while undertaking various community programs of community service. There are 24 wheels in the 'Rath' of the Sun Temple of Konark. Each wheel has eight bars, which represent 8 pahars of day. Hence, the badge reminds the wearer to be in readiness for service of the nation round the clock, i.e., lively, active, and spirited. The Navy blue colour indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny party ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind



The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of JSS Academy of Technical Education (JSSATE), Bengaluru, conducted a Rain Water Harvesting and Water Conservation Awareness Campaign from 4th to 9th May 2024 at Basavanagudi, South West 3 Division, Bengaluru, with 75 student volunteers. The campaign aimed to raise awareness about the importance of rainwater harvesting (RWH), promote water conservation practices, and collect data on existing RWH systems and public willingness to adopt sustainable water management methods. Volunteers were trained in RWH techniques, conservation strategies, and effective communication, and a detailed survey was designed to assess awareness levels and implementation status among residents.

Through a door-to-door survey covering around 500 households, volunteers explained the benefits of rainwater harvesting, demonstrated simple water-saving techniques, and distributed informational materials. The campaign significantly improved community awareness about water conservation and RWH, encouraged residents to adopt sustainable practices, and provided practical knowledge and resources to support the implementation of rainwater harvesting systems.









Ragging: Ragging was described as a serious, non-bailable offense with a strong appeal for students to report any incidents and avoid involvement.

The motivational words from Mrs. Manjula and Mr. Srinivas emphasize vigilance, self-awareness, and a commitment to societal well-being. The event served as a powerful reminder of the critical role of youth in shaping a safer, healthier, and more prosperous nation. Dr. C V Vinay concluded the session with a vote of thanks.



The data collected during the survey will be utilized to create contour maps and determine optimal pit locations to maximize water retention and minimize runoff.
